







OVER **40%** OF SENIORS RELY ON SOCIAL SECURITY FOR A MAJORITY OF THEIR INCOME




THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT SPENDS **\$6** PER SENIOR FOR EVERY **\$1** IT SPENDS PER CHILD


THE LAW REQUIRES A **24%** BENEFIT CUT FOR ALL AFTER INSOLVENCY



BENEFIT CUTS WILL BE OVER **18K** FOR A TYPICAL COUPLE




Average Life Expectancy
